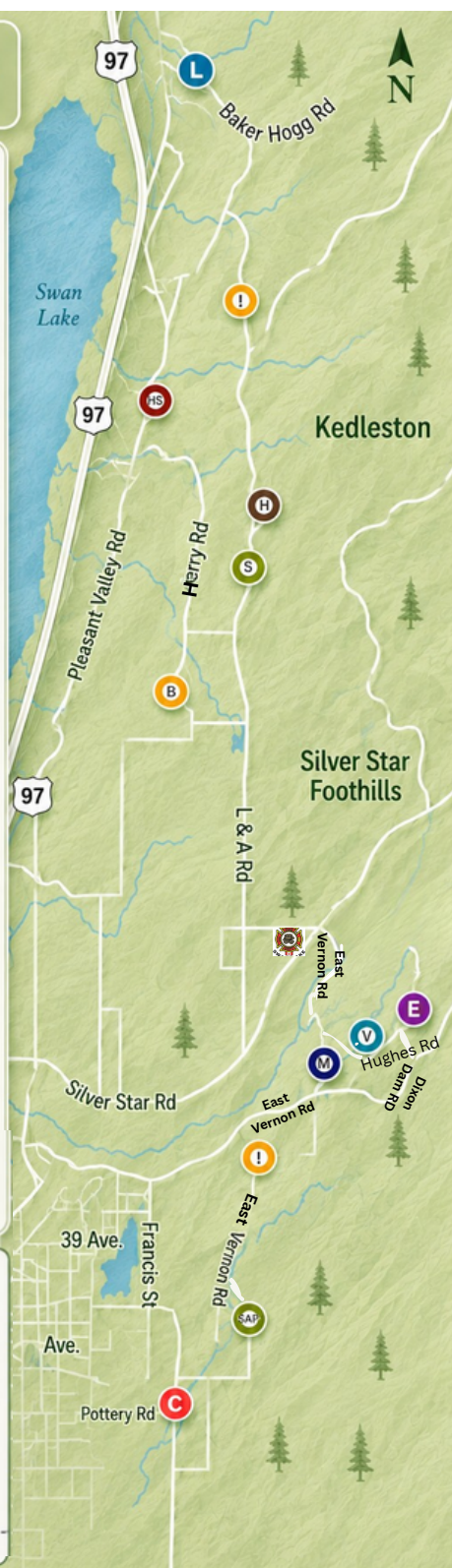

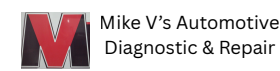
Local Stops of Interest
